

Fishing Creek Lake Flooding Update – July 11, 2026 12:30 p.m.

- Flooding is currently impacting the North Shore, Resort Village of Leslie Beach and the Resort Village of Chorney Beach.
- SPSA crews and equipment remain on site in the community for the foreseeable future. There are no immediate plans to leave these areas.
 - As crew members go on scheduled days of rest, new crew members will be brought in so that there is no gap in service.
- SPSA staff remain in communication with community leaders to provide support and updates.
- SPSA crews are currently focusing on priority areas that are most in need with sandbags and pumps.
 - These would be areas that are facing the greatest flooding impacts.
 - Once these areas are addressed, the SPSA will move to secondary areas.
- To date, the SPSA is not aware of any structures lost due to flooding in this area.
- Volunteers and crews continue to work long days in extreme heat conditions. Thank you to these individuals for their contributions.
