Zenneth Faye moved and seconded by Perry Anderson that the agenda be approved as presented. **CARRIED.**

Rory Woroniuk moved and seconded by Angie Panio that the minutes from August 12, 2023 Annual Meeting be approved as circulated. **CARRIED.**

Michael Rattray moved the Financial Statements be approved as read. Seconded by Diane Kreiger. **CARRIED.**

Note: \$339,175.48 on reserve with \$150,000.00 allocated to berm repairs if needed.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- a. Ben Perry posted information sheet on our Hamlet website on water levels. Weir is west of gate. Land elevation is very level, so discharge is very slow. Three middle gates are open. North and South gates are closed. Pelican Lake is full so hardly any flow. Water Security Agency is in charge and instructions when the gates need to be adjusted, not the RM. (Rob McClain) has authority of opening and closing gates as instructed.
- b. TRAILER LICENSE: Update will be on our tax notice. Some concern of people using trailers but taking their garbage home. “Why do they have to pay a trailer tax?” Darcy Malinowski explained that money collected also goes towards streetlights, road maintenance, pumps, signs, pest control, gravel, etc. License Fee for the year is \$225.00 for first trailer and \$400.00 for each additional trailer thereafter. No charge if you have a visitor for a week or two and trailer is removed. Changes to the bylaw can still be made. Write a

- c. **UNTIDY & UNSIGHTLY PROPERTY:** Those present asked the RM to take action and charge “clean up” to the property owner of their next year’s taxes.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- a. Darcy looked at issues of drainage lines. Roto Rooter from Regina called. Breakage at Murray Beach. One end of Ottman’s Beach is blocked by tree roots.
- b. Dwayne stated that two inspections are required each year of the Berm. (One by drone and the other by walking the Berm).
- c. If you want notifications from the RM in text or email format, please complete the consent form.
- d. Ben Perry gave report for Pavillion Beach. Speed bumps are installed. More gravel required on roads. Will have to wait until Fall when speed bumps are removed.
- e. Darcy Malinowski gave report for Ottman Beach. Water drainage issue is being look at. More gravel on roads in the Fall.
- f. Walter Peterson gave report for Murray Beach. Still some issues with landowners to clean up lots. Three new lots have been purchased and cleaned up. Gray cabin and mobile home an eye sore. Asking the RM to intervene.

Zenneth Faye asked about crime issues and what is being done. “Call Police” for right now.
