

**BYLAW No. 2-2022**  
**A BYLAW OF THE RM OF SASMAN No. 336 TO AMEND BYLAW**  
**No. 02-2017 KNOWN AS THE OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Sasman No. 336, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw 02-2017 as follows:

1. **SUBSECTION 3.6 HAMLETS**, is amended by adding in following section after “Ottoman-Murray Fishing Lake”:

**Margo** – this special service area of the RM was previously the Village of Margo. As of January 1, 2021, the village dissolved into the RM as a special service area. Margo has approximately of 83 full-time residents. The special service area is primarily residential dwellings with a few businesses including post office, bank, and farming business. Water and sewer systems are existing in the community. However, the systems would require upgrades if capacity were to increase. Margo also has a hall available for the community members. The RM provides snow plowing and fire protection.

2. **APPENDIX “C”, SUBCLAUSE 1.1 WELCOME TO THE RM OF SASMAN OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN, second paragraph** is amended by deleting “The Village of Margo is the only urban municipality.” and replacing it with “The special service area of Margo has been annexed into the RM of Sasman as of January 1, 2021.”
3. **APPENDIX “C”, SECTION 2: REGIONAL OVERVIEW**, 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph is amended by, changing “Village of Margo” to “Special Service Area of Margo.”
  - d. Buildings, uses, structures generally considered a companion and accessory to an established permitted or discretionary use. In the context of this district this may include decks, fences, gazebos, private garages, storage sheds, and other similar uses.”
4. **APPENDIX “C”, SECTION 5: COMMUNITY CHARACTERISTICS**, last paragraph is amended by replacing “Village of Margo” with “Special Service Area of Margo”.

**This bylaw shall become effective on the date of approval of the Minister of Government Relations.**
