

BYLAW NO. 2-2020

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SASMAN NO. 336

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE “DOUKHOBOUR SOCIETY” CEMETERY SITUATED NEAR KYLEMORE, SASKATCHEWAN

WHEREAS the Doukhobour Society of Kylemore, Saskatchewan, owns and maintains a cemetery at Kylemore, Saskatchewan, on lands more particularly described as:

Fraction of the SE 9-34-12-W2nd

AND WHEREAS the said owner of the land is desirous of having the Rural Municipality of Sasman No. 336 assume responsibility for the maintenance and orderly care of the said cemetery;

AND WHEREAS the owner of the land has entered into an agreement with the Rural Municipality of Sasman No. 336 regarding such maintenance, care and control of the cemetery;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Sasman No. 336 enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Sasman No. 336 shall hereinafter be responsible for the maintenance of the cemetery and grounds known as the “God’s Blessing Cemetery” situated near the Hamlet of Kylemore, Saskatchewan on lands more particularly described as:

Fraction of the SE 9-34-12-W2nd

2. The Council of the Rural Municipality of Sasman No. 336 and its agents shall have control of all maintenance performed and upon approval of the Provincial Secretary (“The Minister”) shall be deemed to be the owner of the said lands.
3. The R.M. Council shall have full discretion in deciding what work or works are required to be done to properly maintain the cemetery grounds and to determine the costs related to such works, subject to the written agreement annexed hereto and marked Exhibit “A” to this bylaw.
4. The R.M. Council will offset the expenses from year to year for the maintenance of the Kylemore Cemetery by using monies that are donated to the Kylemore Cemetery and if need be use monies collected from the tax levy from the Hamlet of Kylemore.
5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the final passing thereof.
6. Bylaw Number 65/88 dated January 12, 1988 is hereby repealed.
