

BYLAW NO. 2025-01

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM IN THE HAMLET OF KUROKI AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY WAY OF A SERVICE CHARGE FOR THE USE OF WATER & SEWER

WHEREAS the Council may regulate the distribution and use of water and sewer in the Hamlet of Kuroki and may fix the rates for the use thereof and times of payment.

COUNCIL of the *Rural Municipality of Sasman No. 336* in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. All lots will be supplied with water from the Hamlet water supply system and sewer services.
2. The Municipality shall have the right to ration or limit the amount of the water furnished to any or all consumers should circumstances warrant such action.
3. If the water supply is shut off from the premises of the user for infringement of the provisions of this bylaw, same shall not be turned on until all penalties, fees and arrears, have been paid in full.
4. The following rates per month shall apply for the use of water & sewer from the Hamlet of Kuroki water distribution systems:

Table with 3 columns: Fees, Water, Sewer. Values: \$85.00, \$10.00, \$95.00 per month.

- These fees apply to the following: Residential & Seasonal Residential, General stores, Manse of Rectory, Garage/Service Station, Hotel, Municipal Office, Grain Elevators

- 5. The following rates per month shall apply for the use of water & sewer from the Hamlet of Kuroki water distribution systems:

Table with 3 columns: Fees, Recreation (halls, etc), Churches. Values: \$50.00 per month, \$60.00 per month.

- 6. All rates, costs or charges made under the authority of this bylaw shall be preferential lien and charge on the house, tenement, lot or part of a lot; and may be levied and collected in like the manner and municipal rates and taxes are recoverable that maybe added onto the tax roll.
7. The rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee.
8. Bylaw No. 2-2023 is hereby repealed at time of adoption of this bylaw.
