

BYLAW NO. 10/2022

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM IN THE SPECIAL SERVICE AREA OF MARGO AND TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY WAY OF A SERVICE CHARGE FOR THE USE OF SEWER

WHEREAS the Council may regulate the distribution and use of water and sewer in the Special Service Area of Margo and may fix the rates for the use thereof and times of payment.

COUNCIL of the *Rural Municipality of Sasman No. 336* in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. All persons desiring to be supplied with water from the Hamlet water supply system and sewer services shall make application to the officials of the Municipality.
2. The municipality shall have the right to ration or limit the amount of the water furnished to any or all consumers should circumstances warrant such action.
3. There shall be no charge for shutting off the water or turning back on the service when it is requested by the consumer.
4. If the water supply is shut off from the premises of the user for infringement of the provisions of this bylaw, same shall not be turned on until all penalties, fees and arrears, have been paid in full.
5. The following rates per month shall apply for the use of water from the Special Service Area of Margo water distribution systems.

Residential & Seasonal Residential
General stores
Garage/Service Station
Hotel
Municipal Office
Grain Elevators

All fees for the above shall be \$ 37.50 per month

6. The following rates per month shall apply for the use of the sewer in the Special Service Area of Margo:

Flat Rate - \$ 17.50
7. An Infrastructure Fee of \$10.00 per month will be added to every bill and that all of these funds collected through this fee shall be used solely for the purpose of maintaining, repairing, and/or expanding the water and sewer system infrastructure.
8. All rates, costs or charges made under the authority of this bylaw shall be preferential lien and charge on the house, tenement, lot or part of a lot; and may be levied and collected in like the manner and municipal rates and taxes are recoverable that maybe added onto the tax roll.
9. The rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee.
10. Bylaw 1-2021 dated January 19, 2021 is hereby repealed.
